MMBA President's Message

I am a true ice cream aficionado!

I find it almost impossible to pass an ice cream store without a scoop; who I am kidding at least three scoops!

I had ice cream for lunch today; I once had ice cream with chocolate syrup and peanuts for breakfast everyday for three straight weeks.

Ice cream is the reason I exercise.

My true love is vanilla; I'm a beige kind of guy personally.

That said, I can enjoy chocolate marshmallow with caramel fish, peanut butter cup, blueberry cheesecake and just about whatever you throw at me.

Many local creameries have decided the flavor selection is at the whim of the imagination, which is true.

The other truth is these eclectic, esoteric flavor combinations may languish in the freezer until they are discounted and forgotten.

The same can be said for local craft spirits. In the interest of fair play and confidentiality I won't mention some of the flavors I have been shown.

It is not my intention to be the flavor critic for the Minnesota Distillery world.

It is my responsibility to make money for my city and this is the point where "these paths diverge in the forest." I am surprised at, times, what new product resonates in the imagination of my consumers.

I also understand many imaginative flavor combinations greatly enhance the construction of a cocktail.

I just need the tools to inform my customers of these options but the resources don't seem to be available.

I believe supporting local businesses is more beneficial to the local economy.

I try to shop for my produce at farmer's markets, I buy most of my gifts from local vendors and artists, my free range beef; which tastes infinitely better by the way, is purchased from local producers.

Shopping locally gives me the advantage of seeing the face of the person who aged my favorite cheddar or designed the necklace I purchased as a gift.

I also have a reasonable certainty my purchase will benefit the local economy and the money will be circulated locally.

We support our Minnesota distilleries and breweries; shop locally!

We have approximately 25 linear feet of Minnesota artisanal spirits at Rogers Wine and Spirits.

Twenty percent of our coolers are allotted to local and regional breweries.

However, the support we receive from our local distilleries and breweries is disproportionate. I understand resources are best utilized with the greatest potential for return; that's good business.

But it is a curiosity to me that there seems to be little or no attempt at reciprocity for our efforts and investment.

It is unfortunate we have been forced to reduce the amount of support we give to local efforts, begin reducing the size of our local and regional inventories and focus on products that are supported to a greater extent regardless of their origin.

I am going to attempt to put this drum to rest.

The head is beaten and worn, and the sticks are cracked!

For hopefully the last time I will suggest; support those who support you at all levels!

As stated earlier, the best support you receive may not be local or regional.

Strange alliances develop when there is money, sex or power at stake.

Hopefully only two of these apply in your enterprise fund!

Your store is an asset to your city, constantly strive to improve it!

If you can't or won't, give the keys to someone who will!

The New Buffalo Range Now Open!


The City of Buffalo Lake recently changed the name of their municipal liquor facility from *Buffalo Lake Liquor* to *The Buffalo Range*.





<u>Providing</u> <u>Homemade</u> <u>Craft Beer</u> Samples

Event season is in full swing in Minnesota and the Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement Division wants to make sure those manufacturing home craft beers are providing their product legally.

Under state law, homebrewers providing "tastings" or "samples" at contests or events must display signage with their name and address, and state the product is:

- Homemade.
- Not subject to state inspection.
- Not licensed or regulated by the state.

It is also illegal for homebrewers to serve to those under 21, or be paid or compensated for their product, including receiving donations.



<u>Proprietary</u> <u>Brands</u>

Remember, according to Minnesota Statute, all alcohol products must be available to all licensees at the same price – including proprietary items from Total Wine & More, Target, Trader Joes and Olive Garden.
