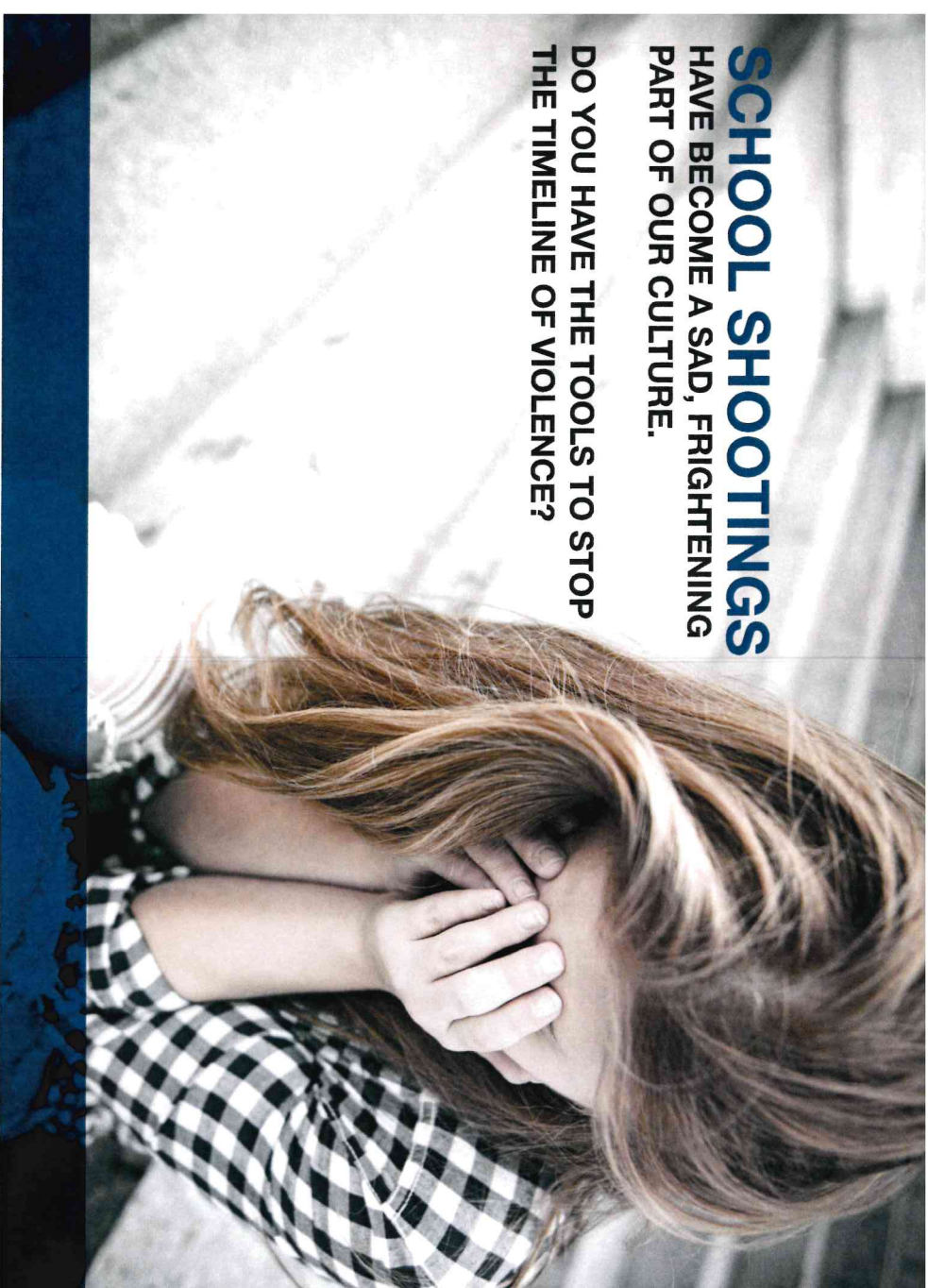

► THE FIRST 5 MINUTES

- Intruder enters building
- First shots are fired
- Intruder takes control of the building
- Additional shots fired
- Staff and students become victims
- First responders arrive on scene
- Shooter ends assault via suicide and/or is stopped by law enforcement

► 3D RESPONSE SYSTEM

- Controlled vestibule buzzer access
- Anti-intruder glass delays entry of suspect
- Suspect dye deployed
- Alert system activated
- Door locking system activated
- Ballistic Security Panels
- Remote Notification
- Comprehensive training principles activated by staff

► CRITICAL OUTCOME

- Safe rooms are created for staff and students and deters entry by shooter.
- Administration and first responders take control of the building and use strategies taught in training to save lives.
